The September 11 attacks, commonly known as 9/11, were four coordinated Islamist terrorist suicide attacks carried out by al-Qaeda against the United States in 2001. On that morning, 19 terrorists hijacked four commercial airliners scheduled to travel from the East Coast to California. The hijackers crashed the first two planes into the Twin Towers of the World Trade Center in New York City and aimed the next two flights toward targets in or near Washington, D.C., in an attack on the nation's capital. The third team succeeded in striking the Pentagon, headquarters of the U.S. Department of Defense in Arlington County, Virginia, while the fourth plane crashed in rural Pennsylvania during a passenger revolt. The September 11 attacks killed 2,977 people, making it the deadliest terrorist attack in history. In response to the attacks, the United States waged the multi-decade global war on terror to eliminate hostile groups deemed terrorist organizations, as well as the foreign governments purported to support them, in Afghanistan, Iraq, Syria, and several other countries. God's Creations



This is a tree that got hit by lightning and it exposed its vascular system. God's nature is so complex. A tree's vascular system carries water and minerals from the roots up to the leaves, and photosynthesized food back down to the rest of the tree. Trees have no muscles (or nervous system) so all of this movement is powered by turgor pressure, (look that up it's very interesting) which is controlled by somata in the leaves that

open and close as needed. For water to reach the tenth floor of a ten-story building (like in a fire suppression sprinkler system) it takes a pump to achieve the desired pressure at the floor for firefighting, plus an additional pressure of 50psi to overcome gravity and reach the tenth floor. A 100-foot tree has no pump. It functions by God's amazing creation. Just as we function by God's amazing creation.
